**BY-LAW NUMBER 00-108**

**A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH ADVANCE VOTING DAYS FOR THE 2000 MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH BY THE COUNCIL THEREOF HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

Advance polls for the purpose of receiving votes of electors who expect to be unable to vote on voting day in the voting subdivision for which their names appear on the voting list will be held on:

1. Saturday, November 4, 2000, 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., at five locations in the City of Peterborough (one in each ward).
2. Tuesday, November 7, 2000 and Wednesday, November 8, 2000, 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., at City Hall.

PURSUANT to Section 45(7) of the Act requiring a voting place to be provided on the premises of the following:

1. An institution for the reception, treatment or vocational training of members or former members of the Canadian Forces.
2. An institution in which, on nomination day, 20 or more beds are occupied by persons who are disabled, chronically ill or infirm.
3. A retirement home in which, on nomination day, 50 or more beds are occupied.
4. That the hours of voting for the voting places in institutions and retirement homes be from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
