

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 2000-124**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2000-103 AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSING OF PART OF CHARLOTTE STREET**

**WHEREAS** Section 207 (43) of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 45, provides for the temporary closing of any highway or portion of a highway under the jurisdiction of the municipality for any period during the construction, repairing or improvement of such highway or portion thereof;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Peterborough enacted By-law 2000-103 to temporarily close a portion of Charlotte Street until September 29, 2000;

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed necessary to extend the period of the temporary closure;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH, BY COUNCIL THEREOF, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the period for the temporary closure of Charlotte Street from Monaghan Road to Victory Crescent be extended until October 27, 2000 to accommodate the reconstruction.

By-law read a first and second time this 2nd day of October, 2000.

By-law read a third time and finally passed this 2nd day of October, 2000.
