**BY-LAW NUMBER 01 - 036**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE TEMPORARY CLOSING OF PART OF DOURO STREET.**

**WHEREAS** Section 207(43) of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter 45, provides for the temporary closing of any highway or portion of a highway under the jurisdiction of the municipality for any period during the construction, repairing or improvement of such highway or portion thereof;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Peterborough deems it expedient to temporarily close a portion of Douro Street;

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH, BY COUNCIL THEREOF, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Douro Street from Mark Street to Rogers Street shall be temporarily closed for the period commencing April 2, 2001 to November 2, 2001 to accommodate the traffic detour plan associated with the rehabilitation of the Parkhill Road (Inverlea) Bridge over the Otonabee River.

By-law read a first and second time this 5<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2001.

By-law read a third time and finally passed this 5<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2001.
