

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH

BY-LAW NUMBER 02-014

BEING A BY-LAW TO RESTRICT THE WEIGHT OF VEHICLES PASSING OVER A BRIDGE

WHEREAS Section 123(2) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter H.8, as amended, provides that the municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a bridge may be by-law approved by the Ministry, limit the gross weight of any vehicle or class thereof passing over such bridge.

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH BY THE COUNCIL THEREOF HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall move a vehicle or combination of vehicles of a class described in Column 1 of Scheduled 1, over the Hunter Street Bridge (over Jackson Creek) if the gross weight of the vehicle or combination of vehicles is greater than the tabulated weight in tonnes set opposite in Column 2.

Column 1	Column 2
Vehicle	Gross Weight Limit
Single vehicle	12 tonnes
Single vehicle with one towed vehicle	18 tonnes
Single vehicle with two towed vehicles	28 tonnes

2. Any person violating the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to the penalties provided in the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8, as amended;
3. This by-law shall not come into force and take effect until signs have been erected and are on display in compliance with the Regulations of the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario.
