BY-LAW NUMBER 02-102

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 192 OF THE CITY OF
PETERBOROUGH MUNICIPAL CODE DOG – LICENSING -
REGULATION**

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH BY THE COUNCIL
THEREOF HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Sections 192.2.1, 192.2 and 192.2.3 of the City of Peterborough Municipal Code are hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:

“192.2.1 Dogs – kept – licence required – proof of immunization

Every person who owns a dog which is kept in the City shall obtain a licence for such dog from the Clerk, or his or her designate, provided that the person shall first provide satisfactory proof that the dog is adequately immunized against rabies at the time of obtaining such licence.

192.2.2 Fee – paid – to Clerk or Designate

Each person who owns a dog which is kept in the City shall pay to the Clerk, or his or her designate, an annual licence fee of \$25.00 for such dog. In the event that the owner produces satisfactory evidence that the dog has been altered, the annual licence fee shall be \$15.00. In the further event that the owner produces satisfactory evidence that he or she is at least 65 years of age, the annual licence fees shall be \$15.00 and \$5.00, respectively. The Clerk, or his or her designate, shall have the discretion to offer such discount as he or she sees fit to persons purchasing dog licences for the following calendar year, during the period between November 1st and December 31st.

**192.2.3 Kennel – pure-bred – licence required – proof of immunization
annual fee – Schedule ‘A1’**

Every person who owns a kennel within the City in which a pure-bred dog or dogs are kept shall pay an annual kennel licence fee, as prescribed in Schedule ‘A1’, instead of a licence fee for each dog so kept, provided that the person shall first provide satisfactory proof that all dogs then kept in the kennel are adequately immunized against rabies at the time of paying such annual fee.”
