BY-LAW NUMBER 02-140

**A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE PORTIONS OF
WHITTINGTON DRIVE, IN THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH, IN
THE COUNTY OF PETERBOROUGH**

WHEREAS Section 297(1) of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.45, provides that the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws for stopping up any highway or part of a highway;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the requirements of Section 300 of the *Municipal Act*, the notice of intention of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Peterborough to pass the said by-law was published in the Peterborough Examiner on August 29, 2002, September 5, 2002, September 12, 2002 and September 19, 2002;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH ENACTS AND BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That part of Whittington Drive being formerly in the Township of North Monaghan, now in the City of Peterborough, County of Peterborough, described as being part of the road allowance between Lot 6, Concession 10 and Lot 6, Concession 11 designated as Part 1 on Reference Plan 45R-12484, and part of the road allowance between Lot 7, Concession 10 and Lot 7, Concession 11, designated as Part 2 on Reference Plan 45R-12484, and part of Lot 7, Concession 10 designated as Part 3 on Reference Plan 45R-12484, are hereby stopped up and closed.

By-law read a first and second time this 7th day of October, 2002.

By-law read a third time and finally passed this 7th day of October, 2002.
