**A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE TOWERSGATE ROAD, IN
THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH, IN THE COUNTY OF
PETERBOROUGH**

WHEREAS Section 297(1) of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.45, provides that the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws for stopping up any highway or part of a highway;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the requirements of Section 300 of the *Municipal Act*, the notice of intention of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Peterborough to pass the said by-law was published in the Peterborough Examiner on, November 3, 2002, November 10, 2002, November 17, 2002 and November 24, 2002;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH ENACTS AND BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Towersgate Road being part of Lot 11, Concession 12, formerly in the Township of North Monaghan, now in the City of Peterborough, County of Peterborough described as Parts 1 and 4, Reference Plan 45R-5869 is hereby closed and stopped up.
