

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH

BY-LAW NUMBER 04-117

BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE AN UNIMPROVED ROAD ALLOWANCE LYING BETWEEN CRAWFORD DRIVE AND PROVINCIAL HIGHWAY NO. 7, IN THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH, IN THE COUNTY OF PETERBOROUGH

WHEREAS Section 34 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, Chapter 25, as amended, provides that the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws to permanently stop up and close part of a highway;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the requirements of Section 34(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, public notice of intention of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Peterborough to pass this by-law was given on June 14, 2004;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Peterborough deems it desirable that a by-law be passed stopping up and closing part of the unopened road allowance lying between Crawford Drive and Provincial Highway No. 7 as hereinafter set forth;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH ENACTS AND BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That portion of an unimproved road allowance lying between Crawford Drive and Provincial Highway No. 7, being Part of Lot 10, Concession 10, formerly in the Township of North Monaghan, now in the City of Peterborough, County of Peterborough, is hereby stopped up and closed.
