BY-LAW NUMBER 04-172

**BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE PORTIONS OF
FORSTER AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH**

WHEREAS Section 34 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c.25, as amended, provides that the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws to permanently stop up and close part of a highway;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the requirements of Section 34(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, public notice of intention of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Peterborough to pass this by-law was given on October 4, 2004;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Peterborough deems it desirable that a by-law be passed stopping up and closing part of Forster Avenue as hereinafter set forth;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH ENACTS AND BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That part of Forster Avenue, being formerly in the Township of North Monaghan, now in the City of Peterborough, County of Peterborough described as Part of Lot 7, Concession 11 designated as Parts 17 and 18 on Reference Plan 45R-8991, is hereby stopped up and closed.
