BY-LAW NUMBER 04-227

**BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE A PORTION OF
CENTRE STREET, IN THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH**

WHEREAS Section 34 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c.25, as amended, provides that the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws to permanently stop up and close part of a highway;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the requirements of Section 34(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, public notice of intention of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Peterborough to pass this by-law was given on December 1, 2004;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Peterborough deems it desirable that a by-law be passed stopping up and closing part of Centre Street as hereinafter set forth;

**NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION
OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH ENACTS AND BE IT ENACTED AS
FOLLOWS:**

1. That part of Centre Street, being formerly in the Village of Ashburnham, now in the City of Peterborough, County of Peterborough described as Part of Centre Street, Plan 22A, shown as Part 1 on Reference Plan 45R-13209 is hereby stopped up and closed.
