BY-LAW NUMBER 05-006

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 93-100
FOR THE REGULATION OF PARKING**

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH BY THE COUNCIL THEREOF
HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Schedule 51 (**No Parking, 2:00 A.M. – 6:00 A.M., Monday to Sunday Inclusive**) of By-law 93-100 be amended by removing the following:

AYLMER STREET	East Side - from a point 40 metres south of the south curb line of Simcoe Street to a point 15 metres north of the north curb line of Charlotte Street West Side - from Charlotte Street to Simcoe Street
BROCK STREET	South Side - from George Street to Water Street
CHARLOTTE STREET	North Side - from George Street to Downie Street South Side - from George Street to Louis Street South Side - from Aylmer Street to Rubidge Street South Side - from Reid Street to Downie Street South Side - from Water Street to Simcoe Street
GEORGE STREET	East Side - from Murray Street to Sherbrooke Street West Side - from Murray Street to Sherbrooke Street
HUNTER STREET	North Side - from Aylmer Street to Sheridan Street
KING STREET	North Side - from George Street to Louis Street South Side - from Aylmer Street to east end of street
LOUIS STREET	West Side - from a point 15 metres south of the south curb line of Charlotte Street to a point 67 metres south
QUEEN STREET	East Side - from Hunter Street to Simcoe Street
SHERBROOKE STREET	North Side - from George Street to Jackson Park Creek South Side - from George Street to Jackson Park Creek

SIMCOE STREET

North Side - from Aylmer Street to the westerly limit of the bus exit ramp of the Parking Garage
North Side - from the west limit of 170-172 Simcoe Street to George Street
South Side - from Aylmer Street to Bethune Street
South Side - from George Street to a point 15 metres west of the west curb line of Charlotte Street

WATER STREET

East Side - from Brock Street to Sherbrooke Street
West Side - from Brock Street to Simcoe Street
West Side - from Charlotte Street to Sherbrooke Street
