BY-LAW NUMBER 05-206

**BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE A PORTION OF
BRUNSWICK AVENUE IN THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH**

WHEREAS Section 34 of the *Municipal Act 2001*, c.25, as amended, provides that the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws to permanently stop and close part of a highway;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the requirements of Section 34(1) of the *Municipal Act 2001*, public notice of the intention of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Peterborough to pass this by-law was given on September 26, 2005;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Peterborough deems it desirable that a by-law be passed stopping up and closing a portion of Brunswick Avenue as hereinafter set forth;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH ENACTS AND BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That that portion of Brunswick Avenue according to Registered Plan 188, shown as Part 3 on Reference Plan 45R-13515, is hereby stopped up and closed.

By-law read a first and second time this 3rd day of October, 2005.

By-law read a third time and finally passed this 3rd day of October, 2005.
