BY-LAW NUMBER 05-250

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 624 OF THE CITY OF
PETERBOROUGH MUNICIPAL CODE (Sign By-law)**

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH BY THE COUNCIL
THEREOF HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 624 of the City of Peterborough Municipal Code be amended as follows:

(a) By adding the following definition to Article 2.1.2:

“Election Campaign Sign: a sign which:

- i) advertises or promotes a candidate in a Federal, Provincial or Municipal election, including an election of a local board or commission; or
- ii) is intended to influence persons to vote for or against any question or by-law submitted to the electors under the ***Municipal Elections Act*** 1996.”

(b) By adding the following Article:

“12.0 ELECTION CAMPAIGN SIGNS

12.1 Regulations

- a) Election campaign signs shall not be permitted on any property owned by The Corporation of the City of Peterborough prior to:
 - i) Labour Day, for a Municipal election; and
 - ii) the date of issuance of the Writ of Election, for a Federal or Provincial election;

and not later than three (3) days following voting day in any such election.”
