BY-LAW NUMBER 07-025

BEING A BY-LAW TO EXTEND THE HERITAGE PROPERTY TAX RELIEF PROGRAM TO THE PROPERTY AT 17 MERINO ROAD, COMMONLY KNOWN AS MERINO

WHEREAS Section 8 of By-law 03-208 provides that Council may, by by-law, extend the Heritage Property Tax Relief Program to any property in the City, on a case-by-case basis;

AND WHEREAS, on the advice of the Peterborough Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee, Council deems it appropriate to extend the Program to the property at 17 Merino Road;

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH BY THE COUNCIL THEREOF HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Heritage Property Tax Relief Program is hereby extended to the property municipally known as 17 Merino Road, in the City of Peterborough, and commonly known as Merino.
