BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE CONSTRUCTION OF THE \$6,399,900 RENOVATION OF POLICE HEADQUARTERS AND THE ISSUANCE OF TAX SUPPORTED DEBENTURES TO A MAXIMUM OF \$5,822,000 TO FINANCE A PORTION OF THE WORK

WHEREAS at its February 26, 2007 meeting Council of the City of Peterborough adopted the 2007 Capital Budget which included project number 3.02 which was a \$6,399,900 project for the renovation of Police Headquarters.

AND WHEREAS a \$5,822,000 portion of the total cost of the project is to be financed from tax supported debentures.

AND WHEREAS the Treasurer has calculated an updated limit for the Corporation of the City of Peterborough using its most recent financial debt and obligation limit determined by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs in accordance with the provisions of Ontario Regulation 403/02 (the "Limit");

AND WHEREAS the Treasurer has calculated the estimated annual amount payable in respect of the capital work described in this by-law to be financed by debenture and has determined that such estimated annual amount payable will not cause the Corporation's total annual debt repayment to exceed the Limit;

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH, BY COUNCIL THEREOF, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the design and construction of the Police Headquarters renovations be carried out at an estimated cost of \$6,399,900.
2. That debentures be issued to a maximum of \$5,822,000 for a term not to exceed ten years to finance a portion of the work.
