### **THE STUDY**

In 2011, the City of Peterborough, through their consultant XCG Consultants Ltd., commenced a Class Environmental Assessment Study to complete a master plan for management of stormwater quality in the City. The plan will result in recommendations to ensure sustainable operation and maintenance of existing stormwater management systems, retrofit of deficient systems and development of new systems, where feasible. Based on the study findings to date and comments received from technical agencies and the public, a series of alternative solutions have been developed and assessed.

The draft recommended strategy includes potential infrastructure, development planning and design and community outreach elements, as well as associated funding mechanisms as follows.

1. System improvements including: restoration of the City's existing stormwater management ponds, and potential construction of 4 new stormwater management ponds at the following locations:
  - Bears Creek Woods Park (Hilliard Street and Franklin Drive)
  - Meadowvale Park (Ashdale Crescent West and Francis Stewart Road)
  - James Stevenson Park (Burnham Street and Hunter Street East)
  - Walker Park (Walker Avenue)
2. Enhancing system maintenance including: annual maintenance at existing and proposed new ponds; storm sewer catch basin cleaning and sewer flushing program; and street sweeping program.
3. Improved System surveillance/monitoring program.
4. Review and update of sewer use by-law.
5. Inclusion of stormwater management policies in Official Plan Update.
6. Update of City design standards to promote innovative design and Low Impact Development.
7. Community outreach including: public awareness campaign; and, collaboration with others working on similar initiatives.

### **THE PROCESS**

The study is being carried out in accordance with the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* document (October 2000, as amended in 2007 & 2011). When completed, the Environmental Study Report will be placed on the public record for review by the public and agencies.
