The fourth installment of the City's 2005 property tax bill is due on September 30th, 2005.

Members of the Amalgamated Transit Union (ATU) Local 1320, the membership of which operate City of Peterborough buses and Handi-Vans are in the midst of a strike and have the legal right to set up picket lines outside City Facilities including City Hall.

Taxpayers wishing to avoid crossing picket lines are reminded taxes can be paid in a number of ways including:

- by mail addressed to Tax Office, 500 George Street North, K9H 3R9
- at any branch of a chartered bank, trust company or credit union in the City of Peterborough
- by telephone and internet banking
- after hours by leaving payments (cheques only) in the black drop off box located at the front steps of City Hall
