Brock Mission to Operate Warming Room

The City of Peterborough Social Services Department, in partnership with Brock Mission, is pleased to announce that:

The Board of Directors for Brock Mission has given approval for Brock Mission to operate the Warming Room Program for the 2005/06 winter season.

Using the Royal Canadian Legion facilities as arranged by the City of Peterborough, Brock Mission would operate the Warming Room from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. daily. A simple supper and breakfast will be provided in addition to beds and rest area.

The Mission is currently scrambling to get the program site and operation together for the December 1st start date.

For those interested in employment with the program, resumes are being accepted at Kingan House (271 Brock Street). Interested volunteers can call the Mission's central number at 748-4766 between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. weekdays and speak with the Help Desk person, or leave a message at that same number any other time.

Like the Mission's other shelter programs, they are constantly in need of donations of food, coffee, gloves, personal care items (toothbrushes/paste, razors/cream, shampoo, soap), backpacks, lunch bags, and more.
