November 13, 2006 is Election Day.

Some 1,084 electors cast their ballots during a traditional advance poll held on Saturday November 4, 2006, and 4,412 electors have registered to vote through the INTERNET advanced voting option as of the Wednesday November 8th deadline to register.

People who have registered to vote through the INTERNET can vote on-line up to 11:59 p.m. on Friday November 10, 2006. Voters are encouraged to cast their INTERNET vote well before the deadline in the event they experience any trouble downloading the free software that is required to vote. The INTERNET Election Call Centre Help Line (1-866-862-4595) will be open until 12:00 a.m. on Saturday November 11, 2006 to provide assistance.

Traditional ballot voting locations will be open on November 13, 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Electors may vote at any of the 18 locations in the City of Peterborough. Electors are reminded to bring their Voter Notification cards with them to the voting location. Electors who do not have a card can be added to the voters list at any of the voting locations.

Electors are encouraged to avoid the traditionally busy period of 10:00 a.m. at the voting locations. The locations are open for ten (10) hours and they are usually less busy in mid-afternoon.

Although City Hall is closed on Friday November 10, 2006 in recognition of Remembrance Day, staff will ensure that any messages received at 742-7777 ext. 1799 on November 10, 2006 will be returned before Election Day.

Unofficial results from the election will start to be released after 8:00 p.m. on Election Day and will be immediately uploaded to the Election website www.peterboroughvotes.ca. Media outlets will receive an unofficial list of results by fax.
