## Open House for Proposed Cycling Lanes

The City of Peterborough is working toward the implementation of cycling lanes on Monaghan Road from Crawford Drive to Parkhill Road, Crawford Drive from Monaghan Road to just west of Mountain Ash Road, and McDonnel Street from Monaghan Road to Park Street. Parking will be prohibited in the cycling lanes.

The purpose of the cycling lanes is to encourage cycling as a form of transportation on urban streets by delineating space on the road for bicycles. Cyclists feel safer in designated lanes, and this results in an increase in the number of cyclists using the road. The provision of cycling lanes is an integral component of the 2002 City of Peterborough Comprehensive Transportation Plan.

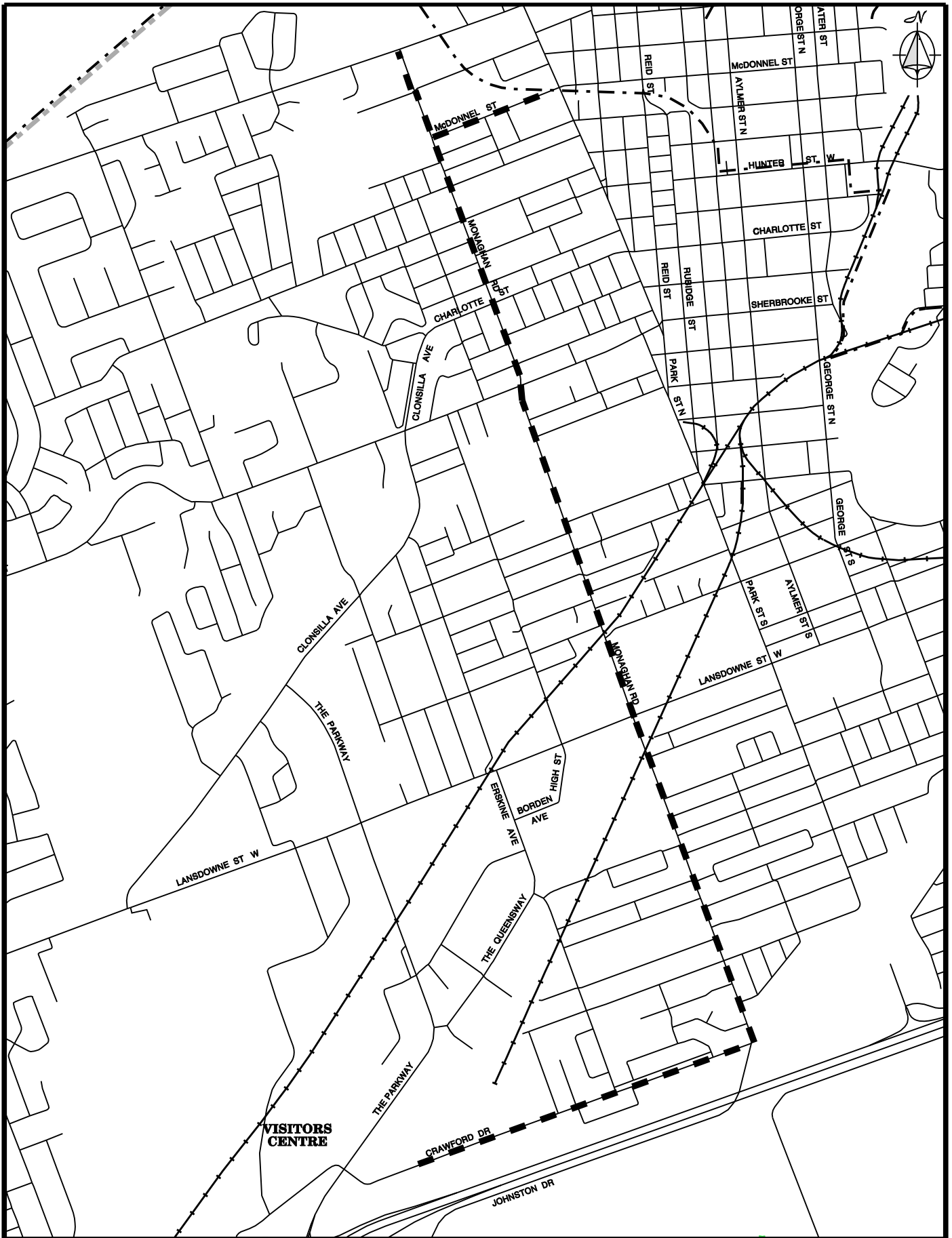
