A representative will be elected for each focus area, housing, food, basic needs and income security to serve on the Mayor's Action Committee. Individuals interested in serving on the Mayor's Action Committee must attend the Nominations Meeting on Tuesday, June 26<sup>th</sup>.

Election results will be announced immediately following the closing of elections on Wednesday.
