Remembrance Day Parade and Road Closure November 11, 2008, 9:45 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

The annual Remembrance Day Parade will commence at 10:00 am on Tuesday, November 11th.

The procession will depart from Peterborough Collegiate and Vocational School, 201 McDonnel Street, travel south on George Street, turn east on Brock Street, north on Water Street and west on McDonnel Street, then congregate at the Cenotaph for Remembrance Day services.

The procession will be supported by a rolling road closure. Traffic will be permitted on Brock Street and Water Street until the parade is in procession.

To ensure the safety and dignity of the ceremony, vehicular traffic **will not** be permitted in the area of the Cenotaph (McDonnel, George and Murray Streets). George Street will remain closed between Parkhill Road and Murray Street for the duration of this event.
