Members of Council Unanimously Support the Tentative Settlement

City Council, sitting as a Committee of the Whole Council has unanimously recommended that the Memorandum of Settlement for the Collective Agreement between the City and the Canadian Union of Public Employees Local 504 be approved.

The City of Peterborough and CUPE Local 504 reached a tentative settlement on a new labour agreement at about 2:00a.m. Saturday, January 10th. The agreement will be presented to the membership of CUPE 504 for ratification in the near future.

In order to respect the ratification process, details about the tentative agreement will be not released prior to ratification by CUPE Local 504.

All municipal services provided by CUPE 504 will continue, pending ratification.
