### CARBON MONOXIDE POISONING

The Peterborough Fire Department has responded to several carbon monoxide related calls in the City of Peterborough in the past 24 hours.

The Peterborough Fire Department recommends the installation of a carbon monoxide detector in all residences with fuel burning appliances. Installation should be completed according to the manufacturer's instructions.

The early symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning are similar to the flu symptoms (headaches, nausea, fatigue).

The best way to combat carbon monoxide poisoning is to ensure proper maintenance, inspection and care of all fuel burning appliances.
