### COMMUNITY MEETING – LITTLE LAKE MASTER PLAN

The City of Peterborough has initiated a Master Plan for Little Lake and the surrounding area.

Little Lake is recognized as a distinctive resource found in the heart of the City. It supports a wide variety of uses in the water, parks and open spaces at the water's edge. The Master Plan will create a forward-looking strategy to guide the use of the lake and its adjacent lands. It will also address environmental and shoreline management and consider land acquisition for future parkland.

A team, led by The Planning Partnership, has been retained to collaborate with stakeholders and the community to prepare the Master Plan. The work program for the study is organized in three phases that will be completed through a process that engages the entire community.

A community workshop is scheduled Tuesday, May 26, 2009 at 6:30 p.m. at the Queen Alexandra Community Centre, 180 Barnardo Avenue. The workshop will discuss the context for the Master Plan, observations and analysis of existing conditions, key opportunities for change and the fundamental design principles to guide the Master Plan. Everyone is welcome to attend to share their ideas.
