Peterborough Fire Services Provides Fire Protection to President Obama at G8

As a Provincial Level 2 Hazardous Response team, Peterborough Fire Services deployed a team to Huntsville to provide fire protection at the G8 last week.

Ten Firefighters and one Chief Officer, along with a pumper truck and the Hazardous Response Unit were deployed to the event for eight days.

Among their many duties, the Peterborough Fire Services crew provided fire protection for President Obama, the Secret Service and Marine 1 at the Muskoka Airport. Details regarding the crew's incident response are confidential.

"I am very proud of our staff and impressed that security organizers recognized the level of caliber and experience, when choosing our crews for the high level assignments," said Fire Chief Trent Gervais

All costs associated with the G8 response are fully reimbursed by the Province to the City of Peterborough.
