### ROYAL CANADIAN NAVY COMMEMORATIVE PRESENTATION

Canada is celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of her Navy in 2010.

The Naval Centennial Committee is aiming to build and strengthen in Canadians an appreciation for their Navy and to promote the role of the Navy within Canada. Through the theme "*Bring the Navy to Canadians*", activities will honour the past, showcase the current, and reinforce the need for a future Navy. Every city, town region and First Nations peoples that have had a Canadian warship named in its honour will be presented with a professionally framed display featuring photographs of its namesake ship, a short history of the ship, the ship's badge and battle honours.

The mementos for the namesake ship associated with the Peterborough region, *HMCS Peterborough*, will be presented in an official public manner at Ashburnham Memorial Park, 300 Hunter Street East, Peterborough on **Monday, June 7, 2010 at 9:30 am**. This important Naval event will celebrate the significant contributions that Peterborough has had on Naval history in Canada.

All events will take place at Ashburnham Memorial Park, on top of Armour Hill, Museum Drive at Hunter Street East. Parking will be provided at the top of the hill and at the Museum. All are welcome to attend.
