Peterborough Fire Services reminds all citizens that it is imperative that air intakes for furnaces and high efficiency hot water tanks be kept clear of snow and debris.

With the recent snowfall and blowing snow, some intakes have been blocked; this could lead to a build up of carbon monoxide in residences.
