BEAVERMEAD CAMPGROUND STUDY – FINAL REPORT

The Beavermead Campground and Park Cost-Benefit Analysis and Strategy Plan is now complete and a final report has been released. It is available on the City's website at:

The purpose of the study was to complete a cost-benefit analysis of the campground located on the east shore of Little Lake in Beavermead Park, followed by the development of a strategy to guide use of the lands. This focused study was recommended in the Little Lake Master Plan, completed in 2010.

City Council will be reviewing the recommendations of the study at Committee of the Whole tonight and again at City Council on January 30, 2012. These meetings are open to the public and start at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall.
