### Call for Heritage Tradespeople

The Peterborough Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee, in conjunction with the City's Heritage Preservation Office, will be hosting a trade show for heritage tradespeople and contractors on Saturday April 7, 2018. The goal of this event is to connect contractors and tradespeople who specialize in heritage buildings with owners of heritage properties throughout the city.
