2018 Municipal Election – Information for Students

Peterborough, ON – All students 18 years of age and older are eligible to vote in the 2018 Municipal Election as long as they reside in the City of Peterborough while attending school, or are permanent residents of the City.

“Students don’t always know that they can vote in the city where they attend school,” said John Kennedy, City Clerk and Returning Officer. “It’s important to make them aware of their voter eligibility, and ensure that it is convenient for them to register and vote.”

Students at Trent University, Fleming College and Seneca School of Aviation students are invited to visit the Election Team at one of two Student Pop-Ups next week. Please bring ID showing your name and your qualifying address to get added to the Voters’ List and vote online.

Trent University Vote Pop-Up

When: Tuesday, October 16, 12 p.m. – 5 p.m.
Where: Trent University Student Centre, 1600 W Bank Dr.

Online voting at www.peterboroughvotes.ca is now open, offering a convenient, two-step process for all electors to vote from their computers, laptops, tablets and smartphones.

If your name is not on the Voters’ List, you can have it added at one of the Student Pop-Ups or at the Clerk’s Office, City Hall, 500 George St. N., or by completing the online registration at www.peterboroughvotes.ca, under the “Update My Information” tab within the “Am I On the Voters’ List?” page.
