Mayor's Youth Award and Certificate

Criteria:

The Mayor's Youth Award and Certificate will recognize three individual recipients two times per calendar year during City Council meetings. Award recipients will have demonstrated an outstanding achievement that has brought positive recognition to the City of Peterborough.

To qualify, a youth must be between the ages of 10 and 21 years and reside in the City of Peterborough. Nominations will be accepted on a continuous basis throughout a given year.

Award:

The award to be given to the recipient is a Classic Fleece Hooded Pullover, dark green in colour, with an embroidered City of Peterborough Crest and a screen-printing of the recipient's last name on the upper back of the pullover and sponsor logo on the lower back. As well, each recipient receives a '**Certificate of Achievement**' signed by His Worship, Mayor Daryl Bennett.
