

**CITY OF PETERBOROUGH  
NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF  
DEVELOPMENT CHARGES BY-LAWS**

TAKE NOTICE that on December 14, 2009, the City of Peterborough passed the following Development Charges By-laws under Section 2 of the *Development Charges Act, 1997*, which imposed a City-wide Development Charge rate, as follows:

09-166 Being A By-Law To Establish Development Charges For The City Of Peterborough (City-wide General Services Charge)

09-167 Being A By-Law To Establish Development Charges For The City Of Peterborough (City-wide Engineering Services Charge)

The rates imposed under the Development Charges By-law are required to pay for the increased capital costs related to the provision of Library, Fire, Police, Recreation, Parks, Public Works, Parking, Transit, General Government, Roads and Related, and Sewage Treatment services. The development charges imposed under the by-laws will apply to all new residential and non-residential development, subject to certain terms, conditions and limited exemptions as identified in the by-law(s).

Schedule 1 below sets out the development charge rates that apply under the by-laws as of January 1, 2010. Key maps have not been included in this notice as development charges are levied on all lands designated within the Official Plan boundaries. Any person or organization may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board in respect to one or more of these by-laws by filing with the City Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Peterborough, on or before the **25th day of January, 2010, at 4:30 p.m.**, a notice of appeal, under Section 14, setting out the objection to the by-law(s) and the reasons in support of the objection.
