

What is LEAP?

Learning, earning and parenting.

LEAP provides support and helps you to gain skills and become job-ready while participating in activities such as high school or Adult Education programs.

You can also participate in school Co-op programs, youth apprenticeships, and other work-trial programs such as job shadowing.

We also offer help for you and your child to attend programs with other young parents.



Who is it for?

LEAP is for people on social assistance who have not completed high school, and parents (single or couples) up to age 25. Parents under 18 years of age are required to participate.

Childcare Support

You may need childcare to attend school, go to parenting activities, or attend other parts of the LEAP program. We can help you determine the best childcare support for your family while you participate in LEAP.

We can also help with:

- School related costs
- Transportation costs to and from school and childcare
- Job search
- Finding part-time and summer jobs
- Parenting programs
- A personalized service plan
- Community contacts and information

Rewards

You could earn an extra \$500 towards continuing your education or to use for your child's education, just for completing the LEAP program.

- Receive advice and financial help so you can reach your goals.

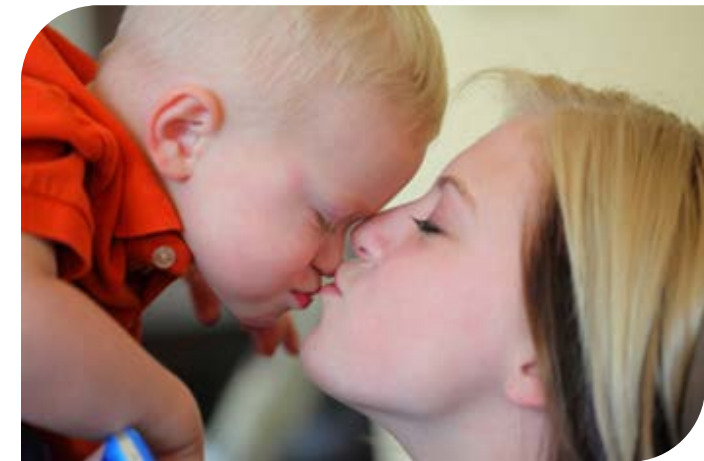
