

2025 Interim Property Tax Information

The interim tax amount is based on your 2025 Current Value Assessment multiplied by a calculated interim tax rate (see the chart below) to raise 50% of the total taxes collected in the City of Peterborough in 2024.

Your property tax amount can be calculated by multiplying the appropriate total interim tax rate by the 2025 current value assessment for your property.

MyTax Portal

In 2024 The City of Peterborough launched an online property tax portal. The portal allows users to manage their property tax bills online, including the ability to:

- View current and previous bills.
- View current balance and payment history.
- Sign up for electronic billing.
- Enroll in the Pre-Authorized Payment plan.
- Update your mailing address, and much more!

Instalment Due Dates

City of Peterborough Interim tax bills include two instalment due dates. The first instalment is due March 31, 2025, with the second instalment due May 30, 2025.



Mortgage Company Payments

If your taxes are to be paid by your mortgage company, please forward the bill to them.

Special Charges/Credits

All additional charges and credits such as Local Improvement charges, Business Improvement charges (BIA), and the Heritage Tax Credits will be included on the final tax bill. Low Income Senior & Disabled Tax Credits are included on the interim bill, unless you are on a Preauthorized Payment Plan, then the credit will be included on the final billing.

Preauthorized Tax Payments

The preauthorized payment plan is one of the most convenient ways to pay your property tax bill. The City offers both monthly and instalment plan options. Apply through **MyTax Portal**, details on first page. For taxpayers who are in arrears, we also offer a monthly arrears plan, please contact the office.

Mailing Address Changes

If you have changed your mailing address, updates can be completed through MyTax Portal or notify the Tax Office in writing to ensure prompt mailing of future notices.

Application for Tax Appeal

Properties that have been demolished, damaged or destroyed by fire or have had a change in use may qualify for a tax reduction. Forms are available on our website at www.peterborough.ca/tax or at Service Peterborough, City Hall.

Receipts

- Receipts will be issued when the entire bill is presented at time of payment.
- For mailed payments requiring a receipt, please include entire bill along with a self-addressed stamped envelope. The receipted bill will be returned to you for your records.
- Receipts are not valid unless the cheque has cleared the bank.
- If you require a receipt for income tax purposes, please keep your stamped bill. There is a \$25 charge for duplicate receipts.
- Bill reprints and a Statement of Account can also be retrieved, free of charge, simply register and log into the MyTax Portal, details above.
