4. If a payment is not honoured by your financial institution, a \$35.00 administrative fee will be added to your outstanding balance.
5. Any breach in the payment schedule may result in the immediate suspension of your driver’s licence and cancellation of the pre-authorized payment plan.
6. If the pre-authorized payment plan is in conjunction with an Order Extending Time to Pay Fine (Form 125) signed by a Justice of the Peace, it is the responsibility of the applicant to re-apply when necessary, or your driver’s licence may be suspended.
