

Eligibility Criteria

Apply for Rent-Geared-to-Income (RGI) housing if you meet the following criteria:

1. You can live independently with or without support services.
2. You are over 16 years old.
3. You are a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident of Canada or a refugee claimant, or you are applying to become a permanent resident. You are not under a removal order to leave Canada.
4. You do not owe money to any social housing provider in Ontario (note: you can apply if you have a repayment agreement in place).
5. You have not been found guilty in the last two years of an offence related to RGI assistance.
6. Your income is within the allowable limits (see tables below).

Table 1: 2019 Income Limits for housing in the City of Peterborough

Table 2: 2019 Income Limits for housing in the County of Peterborough

7. You **must answer Yes to all the boxes** below:

- I, or someone else on my application is 16 years of age or older.
- I can live independently and/or arrange my own support services.
- I am a Canadian Citizen, or I made an application for Landed Immigrant or Permanent Resident status or a claim for protection as a Refugee.
- My household income is at or below the amounts in Table 1 for the City of Peterborough or Table 2 for the County of Peterborough.

Note: The maximum number of bedrooms allowed is one bedroom per single or couple, plus an additional bedroom for each family member.
