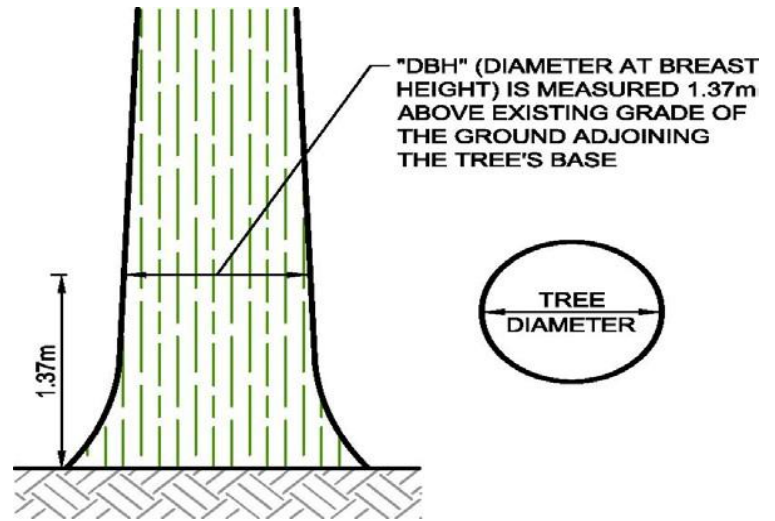




Tree By-law 19-042 notification for the destruction of a tree or trees on private property

Anyone who wants to remove a tree on private property, if the tree has a diameter of at least 7.5cm at breast height, must give the city at least 72-hours written notice before removing the tree.

- The 72 Hour period will start when this notice is received via email to treebylaw@peterborough.ca or in Person to City Hall, Infrastructure Planning Division, 500 George St N, Peterborough ON K9H 3R9. Attention: Urban Forest Manager
- A picture or photo can also be submitted with this notification
- Trees located on City property are protected under By-law 82-82 or Chapter 765 of the Municipal code.
- The Woodland Conservation By-law 17-121 remains in effect for tree removal on properties greater than 2.47 ac or 1 hectare in size
