1. **Opening Remarks:**

Meeting opened noting that we did not have enough members present to pass any motions. No quorum

2. **Review and approval of minutes from December's meeting:**

There were no issues; however we did not have enough members present to pass

3. **Airport Operations Update:**

Upcoming 2 week air event and weekend: This event will feature static aircraft displays and a variety of special events. In lieu of admission fees to the grounds, donations will be accepted in support of the Brock Mission men's shelter in Peterborough.

A B-25 Mitchell bomber arriving July 23rd until July 30th, offering tours and rides for the public. On July 30th the B-29 bomber arrives until August 6th. On the weekend of August 4th and 5th we will have military, vintage and civil aircraft on display, along with a car and motorcycle display.

4. Quarterly Noise Complaint Summary:

Review of statistics showed that the numbers of complaints from the Moncrief line area have trended down since the circuit change, and the overall complaint to movement ratio has trended down since the circuit change.

3 households generated 99% of the complaints during this reporting period.

5. Follow-up on Deferred Motions 6 and 7 from December's PANLG Meeting:

Both motions deferred due to low turn out. Also deferred was the discussion of putting a time limit on deferral of motions.

6. Follow-up on Items from December's PANLG Meeting:

Local and Itinerant traffic has been broken down on the annual tracking sheet Advertising for new members was posted in the local newspapers and on the website.

An article was published regarding some of the improvements and changes made by the airport to help mitigate the noise concerns. The article did not promote the changes as positively as we'd planned.

The website was updated to provide easier access to the PANLG area representatives.

It was agreed that monthly contact with the PANLG representatives would be imitated with member's choice of communication method.

Census information for Peterborough area was provided from Stats Canada 2016 information, showing the population density per square km, as well as the population in the various areas.

The City of Peterborough had the largest population at 81,032 with a population density of 1,261 per square km, and Otonabee South Monaghan (Noise sensitive area's B and D: includes Almeara Drive, Stewart Hall and Cedarbank Rd) had the lowest population at 6,670 with a population density of 19 per square km.

Cavan/North Monaghan (Noise sensitive area C: Moncrief Line, Fraserville area) showed a population of 8,829 with a population density of 29 per square km. Data was charted and provided to members at the meeting.

7. Seneca Update on Night Training and Spring Schedule:

It was noted that a new group of students will be starting at Seneca this month. Night flight training would begin in May and continue through June this year. It was expected that there would be higher traffic due to the delay that the weather and strike had on the training schedule last year. The presentation done by Seneca at the PANLG meeting of March 2017 was referenced regarding the training schedule on what to expect.

8. Addition Note added by Connie:

Following our discussion re: the discrepancy in the data for May 2016, Connie asked that the data be reviewed. Lisa suggested that we remove the data for 2016 which Connie suggested my look like we were covering something up. Tony also agreed that it should be reviewed. Nancy Hewitt then requested that all reports for 2016 be reviewed.
