Bring nature indoors with these simple, sweet lanterns that emit a lovely, diffused light. These waxed paper lanterns come together quickly and easily and show off pressed flowers and leaves in a modern, casual way. Use real maple leaves and red & white confetti to give your luminaria a distinctly Canada Day flair!



What You Need:

- ruler, craft knife & scissors
- iron & ironing board
- waxed paper
- pressed flowers &/or confetti
- washi tape
- access to the internet & a library card

Access Creativebug

To access Creativebug for the first time, visit the [Learning and Languages page](#) on our website and click on **Access Creativebug**, then create an account:

1. Enter your 14-digit library card number and PIN (usually the last four digits of your phone number)
2. Create a Creativebug account for yourself by entering your:
 - First and last name (initials are acceptable)
 - Unique email address
 - Password
3. Select the Submit button

NOTE: each unique email address can only be connected to one Creativebug account
