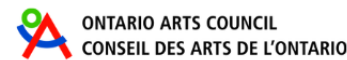

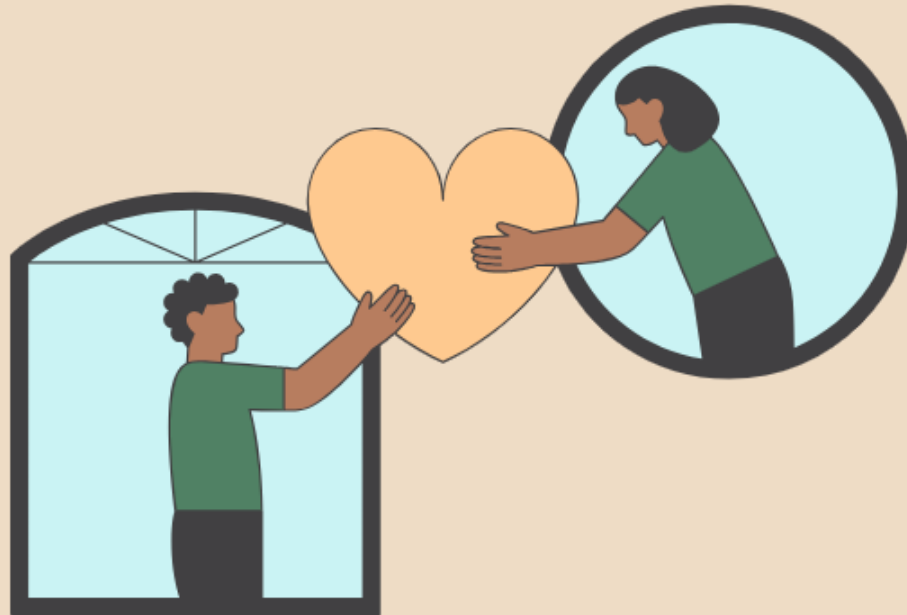

chi mee-gwa-ch gah-bi-zhah-yun



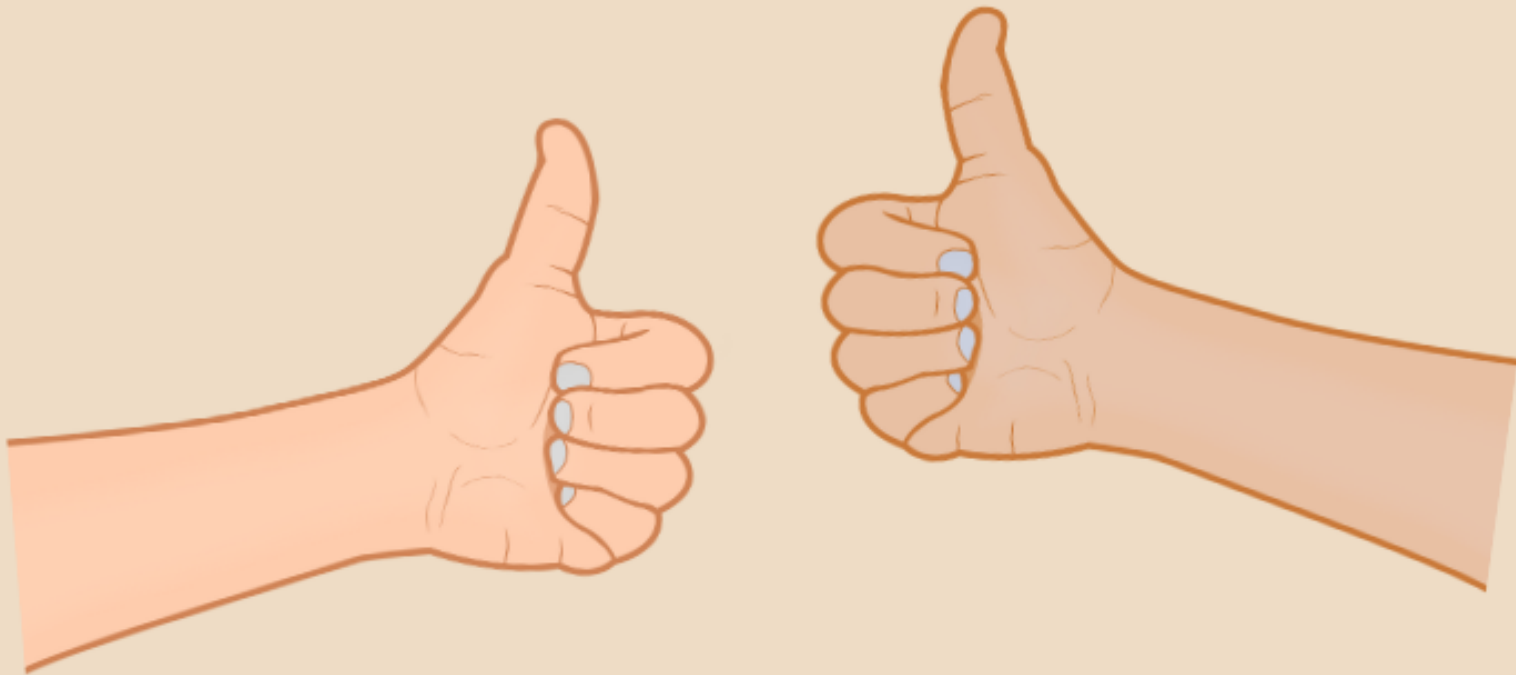
