## 1. Theme

**Focus your exhibit on a theme.** It could be your favourite belongings, memories from a trip you took, a natural history exhibit about your stuffed animals, or more!

Having a theme will help you to decide what items belong in your exhibit and which to leave out.

## 2. Items

Next, curate or **choose a collection of items** that fit the theme.

If you'd like, you can **write a short description** of each item explaining its significance to the exhibit.

## 3. Name

**Name your exhibit.** You can name it after yourself, or think of a name that is based on the theme you've chosen.

## 4. Get Creative

**Design** a display to showcase your collection. Your display should make your items pop and help tell the story of your exhibit.

For example, if your theme is the beach, you could create a beach backdrop to showcase your collection of beach inspired items.

## 5. Share

Once you've curated your collection, named your exhibit and designed your display, it's time to **share it with others.**

You can take photos of your display and create a virtual museum or set up a pop up museum in your classroom.
