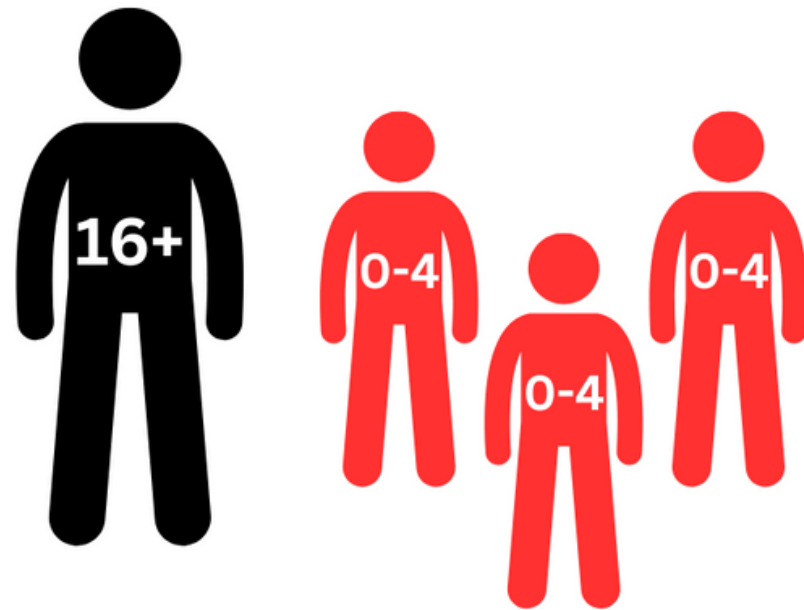


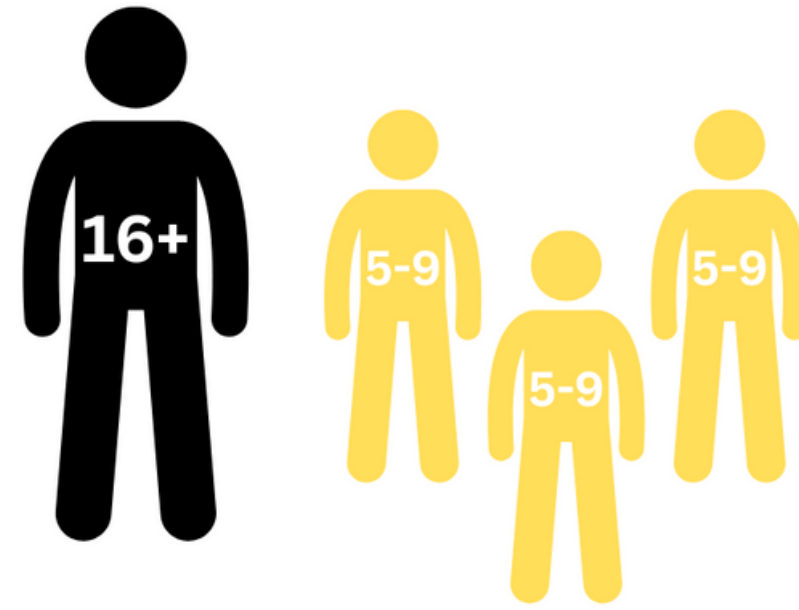
Swim Admission Standards

Children 4 years old & younger



Guardian must remain within arm's reach at all times.
Ratio 1:3

Children 5 to 9 years old



Guardian must be in the same pool as their child(ren) at all times. Ratio 1:3

Children 10 to 15 years old



May swim alone without a guardian.

Guardians must be:

- 16 years and older
- Within arm's reach of their child(ren) and able to render immediate assistance
- Responsible for direct supervision in and out of the water
- In a group ratio of 1:3 swimmers

Facility Swim Test:

- Jump into deep-end, successfully swim continuously on front, one length of the pool in a comfortable manner
- Face and head must submerge under the rope
- Body must remain horizontal throughout
- Cannot touch the side, bottom or rope during test

All swimmers wishing to use the waterslide must complete the Facility Swim Test with an Aquatic Staff, no matter their wristband color. Those who are age 16+ may be required to take the test at the discretion of Aquatic Staff.

Birthday party participants, day campers and rental swimmers under age 16 must take the Facility Swim Test upon entry into the pool. Those who are unsuccessful will be provided with lifejackets or water wings to be worn for the duration of the swim.
