Housing

In applying this discretion, the Service Manager will determine if a Provider's capital reserve is under-funded and if they have achieved savings through operating efficiencies rather than being

Providers previously retained 50% of an annual operating surplus.

Retained funds must be transferred to the Provider's capital reserve. Retention of funds permitted in one year does not commit the Service Manager to future years.
