

Civil Marriage Ceremony Option 2

Municipal Clerk:

On behalf of (First Name) and (First Name) welcome and thank you for being here on this special day. By your presence, you celebrate with them the love they have discovered in each other, and you support their decision to commit themselves to one another for the rest of their lives. This afternoon we are here to celebrate love. We come together to witness and proclaim the joining together of these two persons in marriage.

Municipal Clerk:
